NICKEL HIDE dueled for the lead and set the pace, was allowed to settle on the turn, came again in the stretch and drew clear under firm handling. TROIS DESIR stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and was gaining but too late. QUEENS TONY dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew clear on the turn, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. MOVE ON UP was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. CHARLIE COOL was unhurried early, had a mild late rally and some late gain but also too late. MANOFTHEWEST was no factor while seven wide and lost ground. PLEASED TO MEETCHA failed to menace. SALT FLATS flashed brief speed before stopping. JORDAN RAY was no threat. PURGESTEIN showed brief speed while five wide, faltered and faded.
