LAURAS CRYSTAL was well placed in the middle of the pack, rallied into the stretch, was all out to just last. DEMIDETTE stalked the pace in the middle of the pack, rallied, but found her best stride late. SNOWARS was well placed, rallied on the turn but then failed to sustain a bid. FEW REGRETS was unhurried early, had a mild rally, but was no factor. PISTOLERA stalked the pace, but ran evenly with no rally. LITTLE YARN showed good early speed, but was through after a half and faded. GIVING dueled, but was through after a half, stopped. CREAME BURLEE stalked the pace, rallied but flattened out. JOHN'S IRISH LADY failed to menace. CHANNEL VISION was no factor, showed little.
