### Footnotes

FOGGYSTATEOFMIND stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied into the stretch and drew clear late while lugging in, was all out to the wire. BE A BIDDER was well placed on the inside, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FERRIS was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. I'M THE GOLD was unhurried early while four wide ,rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. TEST MARKET was six wide on the turn and lost ground, rallied on the turn, hung in the stretch and began to fade. C. I. EDDIE set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and faded.
