TERLINGUA'S PRINCE was void of early speed, rallied five wide into the stretch and drew off, was under heavy pressure to the wire. SIR VICAR was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out and ran evenly late. LOU COLLEGIATE was unhurried early rallied on the far turn and led into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. NEVER CROSS dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. PEYTON'S PISTOL set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. FULL VISION flashed brief speed before stopping. KEELBACK failed to menace. OUTABOUNDS showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back.
