Footnotes

MIDSUMMER SUN stalked the pace on the outside while never far back, rallied on the outside into the stretch, drew off under constant handling as much the best. PINK MEOW pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from the inside, led on the turn, could not go with the winner late but gamely held the place. SIX TALES stalked the pace in mid pack on the outside, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. ROYAL GALAXY was unhurried early on the inside, had a mild rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. THIS TRAIN was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. THEWRIGHTWAY was well placed in mid pack on the inside, ran evenly and had no rally. BOSTON LADY showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back in the stretch. LADY WILL POWER flashed brief speed on the outside, faded in the stretch. T. J.'S QUEEN failed to menace. ECHO LOCATION showed good early speed while setting the pace from between horses, faltered on the turn and faded through the stretch. CHIPPAWAMA was no factor and showed little.
