COUNTRY CLUB SUE stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied on the far turn and drew clear, was all out to hold sway late. CACTUS HOUSE was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. IRISH VISION was void of early speed while six wide and lost ground, improved position but was no threat. MINI REWARD set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and faded. PRIVATE CAUSE was well placed early, rallied on the backstretch and loomed boldly on the far turn, hung and dropped back in the stretch. JUNGLE DANCER failed to menace. PYRITE SCORE was of slowly and was never a factor. DEB'S GIRLY GIRL dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered in the stretch and dropped back readily.
