CASTLE FOIL went to leader after a quarter, took over with little effort, edged clear while drifting out in the stretch run. DANCING TIGER had good speed to set the pace early, took up the chase after the winner went by but proved no match. MISS CONGRATS raced evenly and lacked the late response needed in the drive. HEARTS DON'T LIE broke out at the start, dropped back and closed the gap but too late. SLEW'S NIGHT MOVES raced evenly and also lacked a late response. SLICK MISS was never a threat. LITTLE MANS CAT was no factor.
