REGENCY ROAD was away alertly, alternated for the lead and gained command after a half then drew clear. BREEZEONBYUM bore out at the start, rushed up to vie for lead, lost the lead but proved to be second best. WHITE HALL DOVE had no speed, saved ground and rallied for the show spot inside. PLAY IT ALONE had no speed, made a steady advance and rallied wide in the stretch. WINALOTAGREEN veered out sharply at the start then lost ground throughout. SALUKI COVER GIRL pressed the pace and weakened through the stretch. SMART LOVE failed to menace. KENTUCKY SONG never reached contention. FAST GIRL raced up close early and stopped. LIZZIE DID IT stumbled at the start and was pulled up.
