BIOGIO'S GIFT was away alertly and set the pace while off the hedge, responded when challenged on the backstretch and drew clear, was all out to hold sway late. MY MY MY MARIA was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, could not get to the winner but was second best. ALPHA NOVA was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. GHOSTLY DARKNESS stalked the pace from the outside, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. CHOCOLATE BLISS was well placed and showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered in the stretch and was faded. WALK ON was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the backstretch, hung and dropped back.
