O REI SOU EU stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied on the far turn and drew off in upper stretch, was all out to just last late. PEYTON'S PISTOL was well placed on the inside, was angled out into the stretch and rallied, was gaining late and just missed. CPL JOHNNY PAUL was unhurried early, improved position but was no threat. EDEN SINNER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. STEVIE THE LIAR set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch. HUDSONVILLE was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. DUST AGAIN failed to menace. DRIVE TO RISE was no threat. CHANNEL DANCER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace early, faltered and faded.
