### Footnotes

CALL IT THE BLUES set all of the pace while off the hedge, responded when asked in late stretch, was all out to just last late. STRIKING VISION stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and dueled for the lead, found his best stride late and was gaining but too late. BLUE PRINCE pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, rallied into the stretch, could not get by late but gave way grudgingly. EMISSARY was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no late rally. LITTLE MANASSAS was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. COUNT RAJA was no factor. VORTEEVA was in a good stalking position, rallied on the far turn but was seven wide and lost ground, weakened in the stretch. RUSSIAN AFFAIR failed to menace. NAFASS was no factor.
