### Footnotes

ST. ARMANDS was unhurried early while four wide in behind the dueling leaders, rallied into the stretch and drew clear late under firm handling. LITTLE SIX dueled for the lead and set the pace from between horses, could not go with the winner late but gamely held the place. COTTON PATCH dueled for the lead and pressed the pace while four wide, rallied into the stretch and took the lead, flattened out and ran evenly late. BOLD JOURNEY dueled for the lead and prompted the pace while saving ground, was steadied in late stretch, lacked the needed closing response. T MINUS THREE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SO CRIMEA RIVER failed to menace. HEZA WHYZ GUY was no factor. NORTHERN FOG was no threat.
