RESTLESS CITY was unhurried early on the inside, rallied into the stretch and split horses late, drew clear late under constant urging. MR. SHOE FLY PIE was five wide and lost ground, rallied into the stretch and took the lead, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. COMMANDEERED showed good early speed on the inside, gave way and dropped back. NAPOLEON J dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. MR. RAVEN was six wide and lost ground, had no rally. LUCKY JAZZ was of slowly and failed to menace. BRILLIANT BID showed good early speed pressing the pace on the outside, gave way and dropped back.
