TRUE GLITTER stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied on the backstretch and drew clear, was fully extended through the stretch to maintain the margin. SECRETIVE was up close early, could not go with the winner on the far turn, was no match for the winner but gamely held the place. SCONSET ROSE was well placed while saving ground, rallied on the far turn but failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and ran evenly late. WHAT ABOUT NOW was well placed early, was forced wide on the first turn, rallied but then ran evenly late. FABULOUS BLUSH was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. SCOTTS NOBLE CROWN set the pace, was forced wide on the first turn, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. WIN A KISS hopped at the start, was no factor. LADY OF SAVOYA bore out at the start, was rank in the first turn, was no factor. QUEEN VALENTINE was reluctant to load and delayed the start for several minutes, was no factor and showed little. BERKLEY'S GOLD bore out entering the first turn and lost ground, was no factor.
