MARY LANGFUHR set all of the pace while racing just off the rail, responded when challenged in mid stretch, drew off under heavy pressure. SIX TALES stalked the pace from the outside while never far back, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out late and was second best. INGENUOUS bobbed at the start and bumped foe, stalked the pace evenly on the outside and lacked a closing response. GINA SERENA bobbed and was bumped at the start, ran evenly throughout but did improve position in the stretch. ESKIMO ICE was well placed early, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and dropped back. HOT JUNGLE LOVE was no factor and showed little. BUBBLES OF NAVARON showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
