THE SPANISH HOPE was unhurried early in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leaders, was under constant urging to the wire. MAGICAL COURT stalked the pace while never far back and on the outside, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, could not go with the winner but was second best. GOTTA GETCHA ONE prompted the pace and the rallied to the lead, drew clear before faltering and fading. COSIMO was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied into the stretch, hung and dropped back. JUST DAZZLING failed to menace. INTERCOASTAL was unhurried early, had a middle move while five wide, gave way and faded. PRIVATE PREMIER set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. MY DOMINICK JAMES bobbed at the start, pulled up and was vanned off.
