IMWITCHYA was in a good position, rallied, but flattened out. STORMINETTE was in a good position, rallied, hung. SWISS MASQUERADE was well placed, but raced evenly, no rally. NEED THE QUEEN stalked the pace, was through after a half, dropped back. SUNSHINE GIRL unhurried early, while five wide, lost ground, gave way. VALAWAY was no factor, showed little. MISS DUSTY failed to menace. AMANDA was no threat, showed little. MELISSA BROOK put in a dull effort. I'M A DOLL was always outrun.
