ACTS LIKE A KING set all of the pace while saving ground, drew off on the turn, drew off through the stretch under heavy pressure as much the best. M AND EM pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from the outside, was no match for and could not get to the winner, gamely came again to hold the place. TOO MUCH BLING stalked the pace on the outside in mid pack, was bumped mid turn, faltered and was not asked late. FIGHT GIRL pressed the pace with good early speed, came out and bumped foe mid turn, ran evenly late and lacked a closing response. FISTICUFF was unhurried early on the inside, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. DINNER CHOICE was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. DISTRESS SIGNAL showed good early speed pressing the pace, faltered in the drive and faded. MISS PATCH pressed the pace while inside early, gave way on the turn and faded in the stretch. DINKERS MYSTERY was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. MY JUICY COUTURE was no

factor and showed little. LOOK AT THIS CAT flashed brief speed before fading. PETEY G failed to menace. COUNT IT UP showed good early speed while up close early, gave way in the stretch and faded. SLEWBISCUIT was no factor while nine wide on the turn and lost ground, drifted out past mid track entering the stretch.
