DONT BLAME THE CAT stalked the pace while off the hedge in the four path, rallied into the stretch and dueled, drew clear late under firm handling. BRILLIANT BID was in a good stalking position while three wide, rallied into the stretch and led, flattened out and ran evenly late. WORTHTHEBOTHER was in a good stalking position early, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. RESTLESS CITY was void of early speed on the inside, had a mild late rally and some late gain. PRINCE WOODMAN flashed brief speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. NAPOLEON J set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. ICANDAZZLE failed to menace. JINETE was no factor. FRANKS PROSPECTER was no threat.
