SUMMER'S HIDEAWAY was away quickly and set all of the pace while just off the rail, had a clear lead throughout, was well handled and drew off under firm handling. SING DIXIE stalked the pace while never far back on the inside, could not get to and was no match for the winner, gamely held the place. CAHILL TOUR was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. WATRALFAMOUSLAWYER was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. PASS DUE showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. BARBATINA was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. ANOTHER TALE was no factor. SEEYAATTHEFINISH failed to menace. ACTING TRICKY was no threat and showed little.
