MOUNTAIN TRAIL was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the far turn and dueled, drew clear late and was ridden out to the wire. BABU dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, led in mid stretch, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. RIDE IN THE PARK was unhurried early while five wide, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. TAMBORIM was no factor. BUCKEYE'S PRIZE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. FINGER TAPPING dueled for the lead and set the pace faltered and faded.
