URBAN EXPLORER stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and took the lead, was headed late and would not switch leads until late, was fully extended to the wire. CASTLE FOIL was in a good stalking position on the inside, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, was outfinished to the wire. LOVELY JANE was well placed while five wide, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. GRAMA SUE'S POSSE set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, faltered and faded. RICHWOOD AFFAIR failed to menace. A SMILE AND A SONG showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. OH SUDANA was no factor, broke down in the stretch and was eased, was vanned off.
