SCATTER THE ASHES was unhurried early while five wide, rallied into the stretch while widest of all and drew off under constant handling. RACING DEE pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from the outside, faltered in the stretch and faded. JOSHUA'S BREAK set the pace and dueled for the lead, gave way and dropped back. ALL TOO IMPRESSIVE was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. BOURBONANDROSES dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, stopped and dropped back. CARIBBEAN CASTAWAY showed good early speed while six wide and lost ground, faltered and faded. RAE OF SUN failed to menace. FIBONACCI SEQUENCE flashed brief speed before stopping.
