BOLD PEAKS had an awkward start, raced erratic from inside early, swung out five wide for run into the turn and rallied clear late. OUR LAINEY good speed to press the leader, gained a short lead in the stretch but was outfinished in the final forty yards. SAY JAS secured good position, made a bid into the turn but raced evenly late. ROSES AND RIBBONS showed good speed while pressured on front end from inside and weakened in the stretch run. SECRET SPELL raced a wide trip while never a factor. HOUSTON HEIST was through early.
