EASY TO REMEMBER well rated while trailing, moved to contention from inside going into the final bend, angled out and made a well timed five wide move into the stretch while confidently handled and ran past the field while ridden out to the wire with plenty left. STEW BOY with the pace for a half, gained a short lead but was no match for the winner in the final furlong. SQUANDER raced an inside trip throughout, made a bid at the eighth pole but hung in the late stages. RESTLESS CITY raced evenly to the stretch, made a bid at the eighth pole but flattened out in the drive. SUNSHINE BOI was up close the entire trip, raced on the wrong lead through the stretch run with no gain. SMART ATTIRE had good speed to sprint away, led for three quarters but gave way readily. INKI BLANDFORD was never a menace. ST. ARMANDS was through after a half.
