RIDE IN THE PARK was unhurried early while five wide, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, drew off under constant urging. CRITICAL STING set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, was no match for the winner but was second best. TURNPIKE MIKE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. MR. WATT stalked the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. WEEKEND WONDER failed to menace. VINQTIEME showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
