LILLIANS CHOICE dueled for the lead and pressed pace from the outside, too command and drew off entering the stretch, was under a very vigorous hand ride to hold the margin late. FIGHT GIRL stalked pace on the outside while never far back, rallied into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner but was second best. TOMMEYESGOLD was well placed early on the inside, rallied on the turn but could not get past the winner, failed to sustain bid and began to fade in the drive. BASHERIT was in a good stalking position in the middle of the pack, was six wide on the turn and lost ground, had no rally. SYBLES ANGEL was in a good position in the middle of the pack but had no rally. BEEBS was unhurried early, was seven wide on the turn and fanned wider into the stretch and lost ground, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. MY JUICY COUTURE was no factor and showed little. IRISH VISION bobbled at the start, was rushed to contention, was used up and stopped. LISA'S DANCER stumbled at the start, was no factor.
