Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2008, allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2008, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing.

The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters with preference given to those with the highest total earnings. Entry fees for excluded horses will be returned. (If transferred to the Main Track, this race will be run at One Mile and a Sixteenth.). (S)

Footnotes

CALL IT THE BLUES prompted the pace from the outside early, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, drew off in upper stretch, was under firm handling to hold on late. TYPE A PERSONALITY was pinched back at the start, stalked the pace from outside, was bumped entering the far turn and the rider lost an iron, rallied into the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining. INDIAN INK was pinched back at the start, stalked the pace from mid pack, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. STORM BY YOU set the pace with good early speed along the hedge, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. PAT THE ENFORCER was void of early speed, was forced wide on the first turn, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. DIAMOND LAD was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. BUZZ BUNNY was unhurried early, was no factor and showed little. HOLLY HO bore in at the start and bothered foes, showed good early speed chasing the pace, was erratic on the backstretch and bothered foes, bumped Type A Personality entering the far turn, gave way and dropped back. O'RIAIN was well placed with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. KID'S PRIZE bore out entering the first turn, was never a factor.
