UNBRIDLED FLIRTY was unhurried early on the outside, had a steady advance towards the front, rallied into the stretch and was all out to get up in the final strides. MINI MOM stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and led late was outfinished to the wire. INDIAN INK set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. CHESTNUT ANNA was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, ran evenly and had no late closing response. PAY THE MAN showed good early speed and was well placed while chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. NAKAGAWA stalked the pace in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. PART GIRLIE GIRL was no factor. DEVIL'S LIL BIT failed to menace.
