SUNSHINE BOI vied for the lead three wide, took over in the stretch then held on gamely to the wire. KENTUCKY PRESENT had no speed, rallied into the stretch and was gaining but too late. FORECASTLE dueled early, shuffled back, came again for show. PURE STIMULUS was off slow with no speed, rallied through the stretch in traffic, checked and altered course in the late going and improved position when finally clear. CACTUS FEVER never far back but lacked a late response when needed. MOVE ON UP good speed and dueled for a half then gave way. ENTICEMENT never a threat. QUICK CARNAGE raced a wide trip while no threat. HIPSTER ROYALTY raced in good position early, dropped back and was pulled up into the turn and vanned off.
