GREENHILL CHARLIE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, drew off under heavy pressure when taken to the inside. ASMDEUS set the pace with good early speed, was overtaken on the far turn, came again and led, could not go with the winner late. GETALONG dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, drew clear on the far turn, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. O'RIAIN was in a good stalking position, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. TIMAR showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. NO BRAINER was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. PRINCE JENNA failed to menace. COPING WITH US failed to menace.
