VEX was void of early speed while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, began to draw clear late under constant urging. URBAN EXPLORER stalked the pace while never far back and four wide, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, was outfinished to the wire. BABY BROWN EYES was taken back after the start and was five and six wide and lost ground, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. MY CHERRY PIE set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. BIG X'S AND O'S was well placed while four wide, rallied into the stretch, hung and began to fade. SNEAK AROUND was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. STARSHIP UHURA failed to menace. TE ATATU duelled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded.
