BLAZING BLING was away alertly and set the pace while off the rail, drew clear in upper stretch and was fully extended to hold sway late. URBAN RENEWAL dueled for the lead and prompted the pace from the outside, could not get by the winner in the stretch and drifted late. PYRITE GREEN was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, ran evenly with no rally. MIGHTY PRIZE was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. PYRITE MILL showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. HONEY LET'S SHO was well placed early, was through after a half mile and dropped back. SIN AND REDEMPTION failed to menace. PERSONALITY PLUS stumbled at the start, was no threat.
