The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters with preference given to those with the highest total earnings in 2011-2012. Entry fees for excluded horses to be returned. THE WAR DEPARTMENT set the pace while off the hedge, responded when challenged on the backstretch, drew off in upper stretch and was all out to hold on late. AGGRESSIVE ELEGANCE was unhurried early in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, ducked in while changing leads mid stretch, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. STARTIN SOMETHING was well placed while four wide, rallied into the stretch but found her best stride late and was gaining. DERBY DAY STORM was in a good stalking position on the outside in mid pack, was taken up mid stretch, ran evenly late. MINI REWARD stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. CACTUS HOUSE was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. STRAIGHT LEADS was no factor. BOLD AND BEAUTIFUL failed to menace. BOLD MODEL was no threat. PAY THE MAN stalked and pressed the pace from the outside, gave way in the stretch and dropped back readily. CRAFTY TIGRESS was no factor.
