JAZZ MASTER was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch and wore down rivals, began to draw clear late under heavy pressure. T. K.'S TURN was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the turn and drew clear in upper stretch, could not go with the winner late but gave way grudgingly. DEL MAR STORM was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. HOUSEBUILDER was well placed early on the inside, had a mild late rally and some late gain. GOD'S POCKET stalked the pace from mid pack evenly and had no rally. MANCHITO showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. SOON TO BE KING failed to menace. MCFRENCH was no threat. THUNDER COUNTER showed brief speed dueling for the lead, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
