Footnotes

SERVICE MISS set the pace with good early speed, drew off on the far turn, was under constant handling through the stretch to hold the margin. LIGHT ON HER TOES was well placed on the inside early, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, ran evenly late and lacked a closing response. CLAIRE'S ROCKETTE was well placed on the outside early, rallied on the second turn and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and began to fade. JOANAIR was unhurried early, was wide on the turn and lost ground, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. NOT ANOTHER ONE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. WICKLOW LASS was void of early speed, passed tiring rivals but was no factor. THIS TRAIN was no threat, drifted out badly in the stretch and was never in the hunt. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES was no factor and showed little. SAILONTEJANO showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and faded. SIERRA SANDS dueled for the lead early from the inside, gave way and bore out entering the stretch, was eased late.
