BOOTS dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew clear in upper stretch, was all out to last late. CHARTER LESSON dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, gave way grudgingly. OAK RICH was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. I'M ON A QUEST was unhurried early, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and started to fade. TRIPPLICITY pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, faltered in the stretch and faded. FLYING C failed to menace. NITA RIDGE was no threat. PROSPECTSLOOKINGUP flashed brief speed before fading.
