RUNWAY MODEL bore out at the start and had to be steadied, rallied on the turn and took the lead, drew off in upper stretch when let loose, was ridden out to the wire. SWEDE duelled for the lead and pressed the pace from the inside, could not go with and was no match for the winner, was clearly second best. A. P. SHEAUXGIRL bobbed and was bumped at the start, was wide on the turn and lost ground, improved position in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. SOUTHERN SERENITY was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. MISS ROCKET JAG bore out and bumped foe at the start, was up close chasing the pace early, gave way in the stretch. DEVIIOUS CAT flashed brief speed on the inside, had no rally. MORE THAN PERFECT duelled for the lead early, was through after a half mile and dropped back in the stretch. AMY'S RUNAWAY was no factor and showed little. HIT 'N GIGGLE was pinched back soon after the start, was no factor.
