FISKBURG was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and dueled, was all out to hold sway late. TITO was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out and could not get by late. OUTLAW ACADEMY dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. TEA TABLE dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, gave way and dropped back. HIGHSPEEDINTERNET was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, the rider lost the whip and ran evenly late. SIR VICAR pressed the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. ALL JACKED UP bobbled at the start, was no factor. PERFECT HONOR failed to menace. GRUDGEHOLDER was no threat.
