Footnotes

RED BOOMERANG rated just off pace, ranged up three wide around the turn and drew off through the final furlong under steady hand urging. CHARTER LESSON showed good speed, dueled from the two path but was no match for winner in the late going and was clearly second best. WESTERN WORLD had inside position to the turn, dropped back from along the rail then came again through the stretch for show. OAK RICH never far back but lacked the late response needed in the drive. DANASLAM was never a factor. TENDENCY flashed good speed from the rail for a half and stopped thereafter. DELTA CHARLIE had his head turned in the gate at the start and lost all chance then never recovered.
