SUNDAYS JUBILEE out sprinted the field from outside, held the lead into the stretch while bearing out badly the entire stretch run while hold safe to the wire. WHERE'S MY REWARD stayed outside most of way, rallied into the stretch but proved no match for the winner. SPADE off a bit tardy, lagged back early, fanned wide into stretch and improved with no late gain. FUNKY NASSAU unhurried early, rallied into stretch with strong urging but not gain on the leaders in the drive. ROBINS WAY raced evenly and lacked a late response. FILTHY CUTE chased the winner for a half and weakened thereafter. THE SALTIEST DOG was never a threat. BIG GRACIE bore out sharply at the start, recovered and rushed up but was used up in the process an stopped in the stretch.
