CHANNEL VISION well placed while never far back had a mild wide rally. JOHN'S IRISH LADY chased the winner from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. PROUD MARY showed no speed, improved position but was no real no threat. WAR PRIZE raced mid pack and failed to respond. MY SENORITA was no factor. TOTEYE prompted the pace for a half and gave way. ALLURA was always outrun. FEW REGRETS lost contact with the field, was eased through the turn and was vanned off.
