FOR MEN ONLY stalked the pace while four wide and never far back, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, was fully extended to the wire. DONT POKE THE BEAR was in a good stalking position while in mid pack, had a late rally and was gaining. CALL IT THE BLUES stalked the pace while never far back, had a mild late rally and some late gain. BRILLIANT BID set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. THE SPANISH HOPE was well placed with good early speed, ran evenly with no rally. NATIVE YELL stalked the pace while four wide, had no rally. TAMBORIM was unhurried early, rallied on the backstretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. MCBURNS was steadied entering the first turn,. was no factor. EASY TO REMEMBER was steadied entering the first turn while in tight, failed to menace.
