NEVER FORGET was away alertly and set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch, was fully extended to the finish. TWOSTEP PARTNER was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, could not get to the winner but was second best. HOWDY BOY RIB was in a good stalking position on the outside, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. T J'S POPEYE stalked the pace from the inside, had no rally. MAZELTOWN was no factor, passed tiring rivals. SWEET TALKIN ROSE flashed brief speed before fading. JUST OTIS showed good early speed chasing the pace on the inside, gave way and faded. SNOW CAP MOUNTAIN was no factor while six wide and lost ground. THUNDERS DOUBLE was no threat. MAGGS was no factor.
