SHE'S A DREAMER was away alertly and set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch, was fully extended to the wire. HEIR DE VYE was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. TERRA'S CAT dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. JUSTIFIABLY SALTY was unhurried early, had a mild late rally. ACTINSINGLE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. SAINTLY SARA bore out at the start, was no factor. ROYAL CHEROKEE RUN showed good early speed, was steadied entering the turn, faltered and faded. PAY NOW PLAY LATER failed to menace. BOURBON BREW flashed brief speed before stopping.
