SHE'S A SLY DEVIL was unhurried early while five wide, rallied on the far turn and wore down the leaders in the stretch, drew off late under heavy pressure. BELLING THE CAT was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. ELEVEN OF HEARTS was rushed up and set the pace, led to upper stretch, gave way and dropped back. GOLD SADDLE stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. ROYAL DAY was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SHAYLEE'S COMET failed to menace. ANTIGUA was in a good stalking position while five wide and lost ground, had no rally. KRIS' KISSES showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
