MINON was unhurried early while saving ground, was angled out on the far turn and rallied, drew clear in upper stretch, was all out to last late. BETSY BEAR was in a good stalking position while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and got through, was gaining but too late. MY CHERRY PIE dueled for the lead and set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. BABY BROWN EYES was unhurried early, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. CRYPTOLOGIST was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. CLEARLY UNDISPUTED was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. STARSHIP UHURA dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. SNEAK AROUND showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
