AWESOME PLAY set the pace while off the hedge, drew off in upper stretch, was fully extended to hold sway late. FINEST VISION was unhurried early, rallied on the second turn and into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. ROAD TRACK'S DREAM was in a good stalking position while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. WALK ON was well placed while five wide, ran evenly with no rally. EAST COASTER failed to menace. SMART EXPLOITS was no factor. ONE WOULD THINK bore out at the start and was five and six wide on the turns, had no rally. SUCH FORTUNE showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded.
