REGAL JULIE stalked the pace while saving ground, was angled out and rallied in the stretch, wore down the leader and was all out to get up in the final strides. TEQUILA SUNRISE set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch, drifted out late and was outfinished to the wire. WHITEWATER WAY was unhurried early on the inside, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. LADY DELPHINUS stalked the pace on the outside while never far back, ran evenly and had no rally. LADY JUSTINE was unhurried early on the outside, rallied on the far turn, flattened out in the stretch and faded late. LA PRADA was in a good staling position on the inside, rallied on the far turn and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and dropped back. SPEEDY TRADITION was no factor and showed little. ROMPING ROSIE failed to menace. RAISED SOUTHERN showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back, was eased.
