FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Weight.120 lbs. Closed December 31, 2002. On May 6, 2003 last chance reservations paid \$100 each. An additional payment of \$200 due by June 21, 2003 to remain eligible. To continue eligibility a payment of \$400 due by July 31, 2003. Entry fee of \$1,500 due at entry time by the usual time of closing. The first three finishers in the Cradle Prep may supplement with a fee of \$3,000 at entry time. A supplementary entry may be made upon payment of \$12,000 at the time of entry. The field will be limited to (12) twelve horses with preference given to those with the highest total earnings.

Footnotes

TIGER HUNT was pinched back soon after the start, raced well off the rail to the second turn, was taken inside entering the stretch, drew clear late under firm handling. LIGHTNIN N THUNDER set the pace while racing well off the rail, had a large lead in upper stretch, drifted out late and could not go with the winner, was second best. BLUSHING INDIAN stalked the pace while never far back on the inside, was angled out and rallied on the second turn, drifted out through the stretch and had no closing response. TEXAS DEPUTY was unhurried early on the outside, lost ground on the first turn, rallied in the stretch and had some late gain but was not a threat to the top two. ORGANIZING CHAOS was well placed on the inside early, improved position in the stretch but was not a factor. HARBOR MUSIC stalked the pace on the outside, was wide on both turns, had no response and was no threat. WILLING WAY was void of early speed, passed tired ones and was no factor. CASH BUTTON showed good early speed chasing the pace on the inside, was through after a half mile and faded thereafter. CHERNIAVSKY showed good early speed on the outside early, was through after a half mile and dropped back. ANOTHER FREDDY bobbled at the start, showed brief speed, gave way on the back stretch and faded.
